

GETTING TO THE STADIUM

Away Supporters Area

Following the match, the area in black is a designated away supporters area.

Home supporters will not be able to access the area between turnstiles C and E on podium level immediately after the final whistle.

These measures are for the safety of all supporters and to enable home and away fans to leave the Stadium via designated safe walking routes to public transport hubs and the away supporters' coach parking.

While this situation is reviewed on a match by match basis, we advise that supporters plan their journey accordingly.

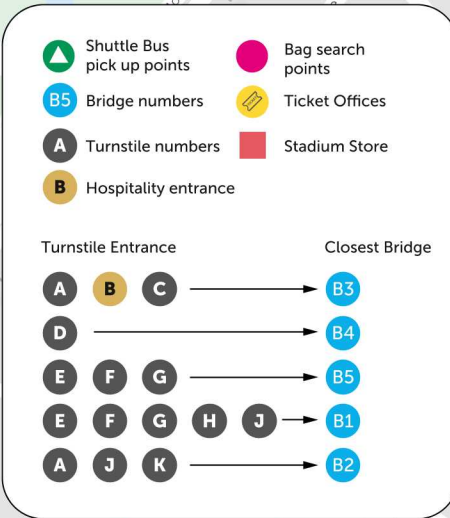

Stratford and Stratford International Station are served by:

DLR, Jubilee and Central Lines.
National Rail operated by **C2C** and **Greater Anglia.** **London Overground.** **South Eastern** trains.

West Ham Station will be extremely busy on match days and it is advised that supporters find alternative direct routes to Stratford Station.
